POKER RUN FORMAT & RULES:

- Contact Brent Kline via email <u>Fuel@bottomlineaviation.com</u> or text 701-440-7449 with any questions or for a copy of Flyer/Rules/or Player Card.
- There is No cost to play and No need to pre-register, but we would greatly appreciate an RSVP emailed or text if you plan on coming so we can try to get a more accurate headcount for food etc.
- THIS IS NOT A RACE. Your time between airports does not matter. Of course, be safe and do exercise good judgment and airmanship. A common Frequency for participating Airmen to monitor and talk air to air during poker route flying between airports will be 122.75
- Must be 18 years or older to Play in the Poker Tournament
- Poker Run begins daybreak of Saturday morning June 22th 2024 and you can simply depart from any ND, SD, or MT airport and enter by Flying or Traveling in any order you choose to a minimum of 3 additional airports In ND, SD, or MT. That's right <u>ANY</u> ND, SD, MT airport counts for a card. Simply stamp player card, show a selfie/group selfie taken at airport sign, or fuel receipt from an airport without stamp for day of play. We encourage including some of the specifically listed airports on Flyer as some have events going on this day as well. Check in at S25 by 3:30pm Central, if experience a delay and can't make 3:30 check-in please text with Name, N# and number of players and photo of player card and airports stopped without stamps and state you are on your way so that you can be included on the last game played.
- If weather looks like poses a concern and/or possible cancelation of Poker Run/Fly-In contact Brent Kline for information regarding if canceled, still a go or if a rescheduled date is being considered.
- At each stop use the Passport stamp, stamping game card for each participating player aboard the aircraft. Each Player getting a Minimum combination of 4 stamps, Selfies, or fuel receipts provided at check in is eligible play for the 5 Card Poker Tournament.
- When stopping at more than the 4 minimum airports each player will receive a card for all airports stopped, that at check in showed proof of stop. At time of play each player will be dealt that many cards from which they will decide what to discard from their hand down to 5 cards before final play starts.
- Again Please when you plan your route try to attend some of the Breakfast and Lunch Fly-In's listed on the poker Route Flyer or that you have saw advertised elsewhere as goal is to get people out flying and supporting other airports and events.
- Game Cards can be obtained and printed off emails sent to airport managers, Pilots Associations or ND Aeronautics Events website. If needing a game card can also contact Brent Kline, via phone or email listed below, for one to be emailed to you.
- All stamped Poker Run Cards must be presented by 3:30 PM local time day of Play. Each participant at check in via random number generated will determine order of players in the 4 games. If delayed please contact Brent via text to be added to last game.
- Tournament Draw will start approximately at 4pm Local
- Only one hand can be played per person.
- If weather is an issue or player just has to leave early we will have someone play your hand for you so make sure to inform Brent you must leave before play starts to arrange for someone to play your hand and make sure we have your contact info.
- 5 Card Tournament Play, each player will be dealt a card for each Airport verified at check-in. To complete each players hand, if needed with 5 Cards, players will then be dealt their additional card. During final play, Players will have opportunity to discard and redraw up to 2 Cards as a final one round of Draw. Players with the highest hands will be determined the winners.
- The only Deck that will contain 2 Jokers as wild cards will be the Deck used for the one round of final draw.
- After Final draw the players with the best hands in each Tournament is declared the winner's. Poker rules that apply are noted below.
- Suit ranking that will be followed will be Alphabetical order: Clubs (Lowest), followed by Diamonds, Hearts, and Spades (Highest).
- When playing with this many decks as well as 2 possible wild cards, 5 of a Kind can become the Highest Type of Hand, Beating a Royal Flush. Between multiple 5's of a Kind hands, the Higher beats the lower, with 5 Natural Aces being the Highest of All hands. Any Natural hand will beat a like Wild Card hand. In the unlikely event of exactly duplicated hands each player involved in the tie will draw a single card and the best card breaks the tie while following all of the previous high card rules.
 - Prizes for each of the 4 games of 5 Card Poker:
 - 5 Card Tournament: 1st Place: \$250 2nd Place: \$175
